## Apple MacOS 14.1

## L2TP over IPsec

- Click on «System Settings»
- Click on «VPN»





- Click on «Add VPN Configuration»
- Select in dropdown «L2TP over IPsec»



- Enter in field «Display name»:
- **SwissVPN** (or other despription you like)
- Enter in field «Server address»: connect.swissvpn.net
  If you use special SwissVPN services like «static» or «corporate» enter special server address received from Monzoon
- Enter in field «Account name»
- <username received from Monzoon>
- Select in dropdown «User authentication»: <Password>
  - Enter in field «password»: cpassword received from Monzoon>
- Select in dropdwon «Machine authentication»: <Shared secret>
- Enter in field «Shared Secret»:

## Unluckily Apple has a really bad default setup, $\underline{\text{NOT}}$ sending traffic through connected VPN

Therefore

- Click «Options»
- In field «Send all traffic over VPN connection»: Move slider to the right!!
- Click «ok»
